The BYC members take the airmen out on their boats for cruises, water skiing, tubing, and even let them use their jet skis. In mid-afternoon, a large sandbar appears in the river where the club members anchor their boats and prepare a wonderful array of food, desserts and drinks. When the sandbar was not available, the club house was used where pool, darts, cards and other games were enjoyed by the airmen and club members. It has been an unexpected reward to watch the friendships that develop between the BYC members, many of whom are prior military, and the airmen. Emails are already being exchanged between BYC members and airmen who are now deployed in Iraq and Afghanistan, and BYC members are preparing "goody" boxes to send the airmen.

By the time the airmen leave the club, albeit sometimes very reluctantly, they have had a great day of relaxation and entertainment away from the rigors and stress of preparing for their immanent deployment into a combat zone. The airmen who attend this day have expressed to me their profound gratitude and surprise at what a great day is provided by BYC members; especially considering the BYC puts all this on at no cost to the airmen. This has become a win-win opportunity: for the BYC as an opportunity to reinvigorate member interest and involvement in club activity, and for the USAF airmen who get a brief respite from and recognition of their sacrifice to the Global War on Terror. We look forward to the continuation of the BYC's Sunday on the Delaware River for the airmen of the Air Advisor Course, USAF Expeditionary Warfare Center, at Ft. Dix, NJ.
